How to get started

International Students with a Swedish Identity Number

Students who have obtained a Swedish Identity Number ("personnummer") from the Swedish Tax Authority need to bring their Swedish ID card or a birth certificate ("personbevis") and passport.

International Students without a Swedish Identity number

Read below which documents you need to bring to the local branch office.

Students from the Nordic countries (Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway and the Faroe Islands)

- Certificate from the school you are attending including the duration of your studies
- Valid ID, please bring your passport

Members of EU/EES

- Certificate from the school you are attending including the duration of your studies
- Registration notice from the Swedish Migration Board ("Registrering av uppehållsrätt")
- Valid ID, please bring your passport

Students from a non-EU/EES country and Swiss citizens

- Certificate from the school you are attending including the duration of your studies
- Residence permit
- Valid ID, please bring your passport
